

- **Your Receipt is your ticket into Vettes on the River.** You should have printed this out, as instructed when you Pre Registered. This is different from your Dash Placard. You should also receive a Placard with this email. Please print both and bring to the event.
- **VERY IMPORTANT TO NOTE... Stop at the Registration table** – Pick up any Items you ordered. If you didn't receive your Placard we will have some blanks you can fill out. Have it on your dash after you park at the show. If you arrive as a club, make sure you are all lined-up together and have the lead driver let our volunteers know how many Corvettes are in your group.
- **Games People Play** – We have some challenging and fun games for you to play this year... A Bag Toss Contest to test your skills... and Poker Run with some of the LeClaire merchants. You'll find your poker cards in your goody bag which you can pick-up at the registration tent the day of the event. You must hit all the merchants on the poker run to place your card in a drawing for the LeClaire Basket. The games will be awarded a prizes
- **Veterans Color Guard Ceremony** – Come join us at 11:00 on the Levee for what has become a very moving, patriotic ceremony that honors all our Veterans, and all who call America home..... get your cameras out so you can capture this event.
- **Food on the Levee** – Again this year, we will have "Big Dave & Holly's providing us with breakfast items and lunch items located at the levee pavilion. New this year is the addition of "What's BBQ" serving-up BBQ items and more. They will also be on the Levee located on the North side of the Buffalo Bill Museum. There are also many restaurants and pubs in LeClaire to satisfy everyone's food and beverage cravings.
- **Mississippi Riverboat experience** – have you ever set sail down the mighty Mississippi on an authentic Riverboat? – Now's your chance... we have teamed-up with the Twilight Riverboat to offer 3 different sailing times during our event. These one-hour river excursions will provide you with some exceptional views, river history, and a different perspective of Vettes on the River from the water. The best part is that the riverboat is located adjacent to the levee so park your Corvette and set sail. - **Goody Bag Pick-up** – All pre-registered participants will receive a goody bag upon arrival. Once you have parked, please come down to the registration tent and pick-up your goody bag. There are a lot of useful items in these bags, as well as game cards for some of our activities.
- **Silent Auction & Raffle Items** – Once again this year we have some excellent silent auction items for you to bid on. There will also be numerous gift baskets to raffle-off. Both activities will be located next to the registration tent so come look over all the items available and place you bids for the silent auction and purchase your tickets for the raffle items.
- **50/50 Tickets** – We will have 50/50 tickets on sale. This brings a lot of money for you and the Vets. Look for the girls selling tickets.

- **Pick-up your VOTR Apparel** – If you pre-ordered your Vettes on the River apparel, you can pick-up your order at the registration tent. Your order is bagged and ready for you with your name on it. Once you have parked your Corvette and pick-up your apparel order, please check it and make sure the contents are accurate. We want you to be happy with your VOTR purchases.
- **Save your Feet and Shuttle with us** – There again be a shuttle provided for our participants with shuttle rides through the streets of LeClaire and down to the Levee so you can check-out all the beautiful Corvettes and check out all the shops in the city. There will be designated shuttle stops throughout the route so you can get on or off at your leisure. Shuttle service will operate for 9AM – 2PM. The shuttle is air-conditioned.
- **Wear your Event Wristband** – When you arrive at our gate, you and your navigator will receive a VOTR wristband. This star-spangled wristband has great powers... It lets you come to the registration tent and pick-up a goody bag (one goody bag per Corvette please) It will also let you get on and off the VOTR shuttle at your whim, and shows everyone you are a big part of the Corvette family.
- **Be Safe & Have Fun** - With an estimated 600 Corvettes descending on the river town of LeClaire, it's going to be a little congested on the main highway 67 as we open the event. We have made some major modifications to our traffic control process to fast-flow the parking... and now we need your help... Our volunteer set-up crews have between the hours of 6AM and 8AM to prep the levee and closed streets for our Corvettes to park for the day. That's not much time to prep, but we get it done! Now for your part... **Please do not start lining-up at the gate before 7:30** as this creates a massive line of cars (both Corvettes & other drivers) through the city and down the highway. This creates frustration for the folks who just want to get through town to their next destination. For safety reasons, we can't open the gates early due to all the volunteer and equipment moving activities. Lastly, be nice to our volunteers... they are trying to get you parked at your designated location as quickly and as safely as they can. Then it's time to get your "Pride & Joy" parked, and enjoy the show.
- **Extra Traffic Help from LeClaire officers** – This year we have additional traffic control help from the Scott County Deputy Sheriff's department and the LeClaire Police department to assist us. As you enter LeClaire on highway 67 from the south, there will be signs to temporarily park off to the side of the highway as you wait to enter the event. Not to worry, the side of the highway has been paved so you won't have to deal with any rocks or gravel. This will reduce the potential of having long lines of Corvettes on the highway while others are trying to just through town. The LeClaire Police will also be helping to direct Corvettes off to the side of the highway at peak times. At the end of the event, officers will also be on-hand ~4:00 to help expedite traffic off the levee and Corvette side-streets to get you on the road and headed home. They will be stationed at both levee exits and highway 67 intersections. REMEMBER... **WHEN LEAVING THE EVENT, DO NOT STOP OR GET YOUR CORVETTE CAUGHT ON THE RAILROAD TRACKS!!!** Make sure you plan ahead to be stopped safely on either side of the railroad tracks.
